

2026 NBS Winter Community Competition

– Win \$1K for your local club, team or community group

Terms and Conditions

By entering this competition (**Competition**), you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. The competition is run by the Nelson Branch of Nelson Building Society (registration number 1781002), 111 Trafalgar Street, Nelson, 7010 (**NBS**).

1. The prize for the winner of the Competition is \$1,000 NZD prize money to be given to a pre-nominated club or community group of the winner's choosing (**Prize**).
2. The competition will commence on Wednesday 1 July 2026 and will close at 4.30pm (NZ time) on Wednesday 12 August 2026 (**Promotion Period**).
3. To enter, a participant must be an individual and:
 - a. nominate a local club, team, or community group (which meets the criteria as specified by NBS) to win \$1,000 by completing the form in full on the NBS website on the page: www.nbs.co.nz/1kgiveaway,
 - b. currently reside in the Nelson Tasman region,
 - c. be over the age of 18 years old,
 - d. not be a current NBS employee or an immediate family member of a current NBS employee.
4. A participant may enter once only.
5. The winner will be drawn at 12pm Wednesday 12 August 2026 at NBS' head office at 111 Trafalgar Street, Nelson. Decision on the eligibility of the winner is at NBS' sole discretion. NBS' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. NBS will notify the winner using the contact details provided, after 12pm Wednesday 12 August 2026. NBS and the winner will agree on arrangements for informing the community group of the Prize.
7. If the winner does not respond to NBS' reasonable attempts to contact them by 12pm Friday 21 August 2026, that winner will be deemed to have forfeited their right to claim the Prize for their nominated club/community group and NBS will draw an alternative winner.
8. By entering this competition, participants consent for NBS to use their photograph and name in conjunction with any reasonable publicity associated with the competition in the event that they win the Prize. This may include publication of their photograph and name on the NBS website and on NBS' social media, identifying them as the winner. Should a winner not consent to feature in any such publicity, they will be deemed to have forfeited the Prize and a new winner will be drawn.
9. NBS reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and the identity of the participants and to disqualify any participant who tampers with the entry process or who is not eligible to enter. Errors and omissions in completing their details on entry forms may be accepted at NBS' discretion.
10. Failure by NBS to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

If, for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned, NBS may (where necessary with the approval of the relevant regulatory authority) cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition and/or may disqualify at its sole discretion any individual in any way involved in interfering or tampering with the conduct of the promotion.
